

Listview filter date function

You may have reached this page because:

1. You were editing a service listview in OP5 Monitor,
2. Added a rule and selected 'last_state_change' from the first drop-down (where the default value is 'this'),
3. Clicked into the page it created underneath, which has a red banner that reads:

```

4. Then you clicked on the word 'here'. You are one click away from the answer you seek.

Ninja uses the PHP call 'DateTime::createFromFormat' to determine the acceptable values. [PHP's page for this module](#) provides the full list of parameters, along with an impressive set of examples.
